

The HIV Prevention Counseling series is made up of workshops designed for health care professionals. "The Facts" serves as the foundation for "The Fundamentals." "The Fundamentals of Waived Rapid HIV Testing & Prevention Counseling" is designed for those who have attended the previous courses and will be administering the HIV rapid test.

THE FACTS is a one-day course that provides information concerning the spectrum of HIV disease, HIV antibody testing and developments in rapid testing, legal issues, disclosure assistance (partner counseling and referral services), risk assessment and reduction, and psychosocial issues.

#### Social Work

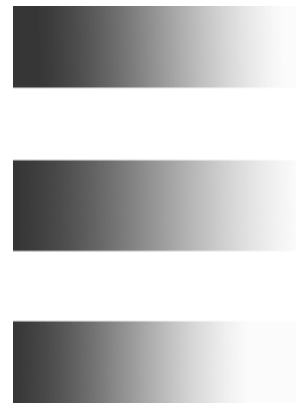
Inova Health System is a licensed health facility. To apply hours spent attending these programs towards your social work continuing education requirements contact the Virginia Board of Social Work.
